- 1. Cllr. A. Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council please confirm the likely progress of works at Kilflynn Cross.
- 2. Cllr. A. Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council please confirm when it is likely that works at the residence of (Details with Directorate) of (Details with Directorate) will take place, post oil spillage in around February 2018.
- 3. Cllr. A. Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council please confirm when works will take place regarding flooding damage on the property of (Details with Directorate)
- 4. Cllr. A. Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council please confirm what progress has been made regarding flooding issues at Gortacrissane, Listowel at the (Details with Directorate)
- 5. Cllr. R. Beasley:** That Kerry County Council examine the Ridge or Barge at the left-hand side of the Road at the Forde, Ballyduff coming from Abbeydorney (R551). This needs to be seriously examined as it is dangerous, especially to people that are not using the road daily.

6. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That the main Ballybunion to Listowel road be upgraded to 'National Secondary' from 'Regional' road. This is something that should have been done many years ago as Ballybunion is a primary town, where the population increases dramatically from March to October and the same applies to the Tralee Ballybunion Road (R551) which should be also upgraded to National Secondary.
7. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** Is it possible that the seating as promised for Carrigafoyle Castle could be put in place before the end of May.
8. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** When will work be carried out on the underside of the road at the seaward side of the Tarbert Island road. There is a great danger that this road will collapse under the weight of heavy trucks using this road.
9. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would urgently carry out repairs on the Killarda road, Lisselton (Dromerin to Killarda) This road has deteriorated greatly.
10. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would carry out repairs on the Derryvrin road off the Rathscannell road.
11. **Cllr. T. Barry:** That Kerry County Council will provide lights along the N69 road in Listowel at the entrance to the Cahirdown Woods Estate and will provide a costing for such a project.
12. **Cllr. T. Barry:** That Kerry County Council will provide signage on the Moyvane to Glin road to make people aware of the Kerry/Limerick border.
13. **Cllr. T. Barry:** That Kerry County Council will provide lights along the Dromin road at the approach to The Writings Estate and provide a costing for such a project.
14. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** Can the junction of the N69 and Woodford road be resurfaced?
15. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** That we ensure that all lights at pedestrian crossings in the area work.
16. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** Have the TII been made aware of the condition of the road surface at Caherdown, Listowel? Can the design begin immediately?
17. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** I call on Kerry County Council to carry out safety improvement work at the Cross in Causeway Village to maximise the safety of road users there.
18. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** I ask that Kerry County Council seek to have the bends at Dromkeen East, Causeway (between Dromkeen Cross and the Bridge) on

the R 551-410 removed to improve safety of road users on this very busy road.

- 19. Cllr. J. Lucid:** I call on Kerry County Council to arrange the repair of the school traffic lights at Killury School, Causeway immediately. These lights have not worked for some time. This is a health and safety issue for the pupils, their parents and their teachers.
- 20. Cllr. J. Lucid:** I ask that Kerry County Council will carry out road resurfacing on the Sliabh a Mhadra road from the cross to Dromartin Cross (L – 6044-0). This road is a busy route and the condition of the road has deteriorated greatly in the past few years.
- 21. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC carry out road maintenance repairs on Ahamore South road Causeway and insure this road is included in our future road programs.
- 22. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC carry out immediate road improvement works on the Ballygarrett road and insure proper signage is installed for future road diversions.
- 23. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC carry out road remedial works on the Kildarda road Dromerine as this section of road is in a dangerous condition and ensure this road is included in our future road programs.
- 24. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC carry out road remedial works on Tullahinell North from Moran's Cross to Ahanagran and please advise when this road will be completed on our roads program.

- 1. Cllr. A. Thornton:** What is the update regarding Abbeydorney Cross and is it now likely that traffic lights will be put in place?
- 2. Cllr. L. Purtill:** When will work be carried out on the Tullahinell – Kilgarvan road (Asdee). This road is in a very bad state of repair?
- 3. Cllr. L. Purtill:** Does Kerry County Council have an update on the surface dressing which is to be done at Creamery Lane, Tarbert?
- 4. Cllr. T. Barry:** Can we have an update on the ongoing flooding issue at Gortacrissane, Listowel?
- 5. Cllr. J. Moloney:** When are the safety works on the Bridge Road expected to begin?

**7. Cllr. R. Beasley:** What is the update on the Rathscannell to Ballinclogher road?

**8. Cllr. R. Beasley:** When can I expect Kerry County Council to regulate the sign that is falling onto the road between Abbeydorney to Ballyduff, coming off the Ahabeg road, preventing proper visibility.

**9. Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council include the road from Kilmoyley Church to Banemore cross including Snipefield (L 1030-24) for road resurfacing. This is a busy route and has deteriorated very significantly in the last year.

**10. Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council consider putting a ramped crossing at Upper Village, Ballyheigue. This is a very busy area particularly in the Summer time and it is very difficult to cross the road there.

**11. Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council change the foot path outside Ladywell Housing Estate, Ballyheigue, moving the point of crossing the road about five metres closer to the estate entrance from the current position. The present location is too close to the high wall making it very dangerous as one cannot see oncoming traffic.

**12. Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council carry foot path repairs at lower village Ballyheigue. There are a number of sections in a very poor condition.

**13. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC agree with the OPW on flooding issues in the Killoccrim area.

**14. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC carry out road remedial works at the church carpark in Ballydonoghue where water is lodging and making it difficult for patrons to access their cars.

**15. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That KCC carry out road remedial works at Doonard Crescent, Tarbert and insure this road is included in our future road programs.
