- (a)** Meeting of the members of the Municipal District of Listowel held on 28th May 2018.

1. (b) Business prescribed by Statute Standing Orders or Resolutions of the Municipal District Members for transaction at such meeting:

- (a)** In accordance with the Local Government act 2001 (as amended) and having regard to Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 in relation to the taking in charge of estates, to consider any objections or representations received and the making of an Order declaring the following roads to be public pursuant to Section 11 (2) (i) of the Roads act 1993:

- (a)** Sli Na Faiche, Ballingeragh, Lixnaw, Co. Kerry - Road from its junction with the R-557-73 to all terminal points within the estate Sli Na Faiche, Ballingeragh, Lixnaw Map 15-11(Serving 48 Houses)

Total Length of road to be Taken in Charge: - 535m

- (b)** Ballyconnell Close, Ballyconnell, Kilflynn, Co. Kerry - Road from its junction with L-2034-15 to all terminal points within the estate Ballyconnell Close, Ballyconnell, Kilflynn Map 17-07(serving 3 houses)

Total Length of road to be Taken in Charge: - 125m

(b) Notices of Motion

- 1. Cllr. J Lucid:** What progress has been made by Kerry County Council in dealing with derelict properties in Causeway Village?

2. **Cllr. J Lucid:** I ask that Kerry County Council allocate funding in 2019 to carry out necessary maintenance to the North Kerry way walk.
3. **Cllr. J Moloney:** Can free carbon monoxide alarms be supplied to interested community groups.
4. **Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council correspond with the LCDC re the engagement of a rural recreation officer for North Kerry.
5. **Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council consider what assistance it could provide to Lixnaw Development Association in putting together a heritage plan.

(c) Questions

1. **Cllr. R Beasley:** What are the chances of having provision for children with disabilities in our Playgrounds?
2. **Cllr. R Beasley:** Is it possible to have swings for older children included in our present and future Playgrounds?
3. **Cllr. R Beasley:** Has there been any sign of funding in relation to a Skateboarding Park in Ballybunion?
4. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** Japanese Knotweed is now a serious issue for everyone. What help, and advice can Kerry County Council give to people whose lands are now being completely taken over by this weed, which may be caused by upstream flooding.

3. Quality of Life - Water, Environment, Fire and Library Services Directorate

(b) Notices of Motion

1. **Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would remove the rubbish including a rusting commode at the side of the Maritime Shed adjacent to the Ladies and Gents Toilets at Tarbert Ferry Terminal.
2. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council contact Irish Water and request that Irish Water install a public water main service to the

people living on the Blenheim Road in Ballylongford. These houses are only serviced by their own private Wells.

- 3. Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council consider moving the bottle bank in Lixnaw Village to the area behind the Railway Bar with the consent of the owner.

4. Housing & Corporate Services Directorate

(a) To note update report from Housing Directorate

(b) Notices of Motion

- 1. Cllr. J Lucid:** Can I get an update as to where the return of the void house formerly occupied by (Details with Directorate) is?. There was a legal issue to the best of my knowledge. The house is vacant for the past four and a half years.
- 2. Cllr. J Moloney:** Can a site assessment for (Details with Directorate) be undertaken so that when funding becomes available works can begin.

5. Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate

(a) To note update report from the Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate.

(b) Notices of Motion

- 1. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would use the duropatcher to repair all roads in villages inside the 50km limit in the Municipal District. It would enhance the appearance of the villages and help the tidy towns committees.
- 2. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would immediately contact the T.I.I. re: structural damage on the road from Tarbert to the Ferry Terminal. This damage is underneath the wall on the seaward side. It is opposite the sign "Welcome to Tarbert". If this damage is not attended to, it could cause the road to collapse. I have already had this motion before Kerry County Council.

3. **Cllr. L Purtil:** That Kerry County Council would repair and creosote post and railings beside the Ferry Terminal. Some are dislodged, and others are broken.
4. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That immediate repair work be carried out on the Laccamore Road between the Listowel Tralee Main Road and Abbeydorney, Tralee. The worst part of the road is on the left-hand side nearer the Abbeydorney side on the left coming from Tralee by (Details with Directorate). The road at this side was left in an appalling state when the water pipe was laid over a year ago outside (Details with Directorate) about 200 metres at each side of his home.
5. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That Kerry County Council confirm that the windows and doors being installed in Council properties in the Listowel MD are of the required standards having regard to recent complaints I have received from some tenants.
6. **Cllr. R Beasley:** How soon can we expect to have the Machine for Beach Cleaning up and running. It has been a big loss during the fine spell of weather in May/June.
7. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That all Junctions and Islands along our Roads be cut and trimmed in the County in the interests of Health & Safety.
8. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That Kerry County Council carry out repair work on the Social House belonging to (Details with Directorate) on the Dale Road and give it to one of its many tenants.
9. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That the Pedestrian Crossing in Ballyduff be moved up opposite the Post Office across from Sheehys Supermarket where most of the Pedestrian Traffic occurs, people shopping, collecting pension, going to Church and Funeral Home. The present crossing was never suitable.
10. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That Kerry County Council eliminate the water leaking on to the path by the side of the Salmon Lodge, Ballybunion opposite the Cliff House Hotel.
11. **Cllr. R Beasley:** That Kerry County Council examine the serious cracks on the wall on the Cliff Road, Ballybunion which has got much worse in recent times. This indicates that there is slippage on to the Ladies Beach.

12. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will carry out repairs to the home of (Details with Directorate) as soon as possible.
13. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will carry out a survey of our footpaths to identify potential hazards to pedestrians.
14. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council get Irish Water to properly restore the Lackamore road from Dillon's Cross to Lackabeg Cross. This road has deteriorated beyond surface dressing. The drain there needs to be piped and the road widened. The volume of traffic using this road has increased hugely.
15. **Cllr. J Lucid:** That Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the road at Glendahalin West, Ballyheigue (L-1033-38). The road there has been patched on a number of occasions and has disimproved again.
16. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Can the drains and gulley from Cantillion's Forge (L-1033-38) to Dreenagh Road (L-1033-56) be cleaned out to improve drainage and ensure the quality of the road is not compromised?
17. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Due to the recent high growth levels, I ask that Kerry County Council cut back high grass and hedges at road junctions and locations where there are safety signs in the interest of road safety.
18. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council investigate what traffic calming measures can be put in place on the Benmore road (L-6041-25), Ballyduff adjacent to the housing estate.
19. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will replace the boundary wall which is in an unsafe condition at the home of (Details with Directorate).
20. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will replace the range and carry out repairs to the chimney which are in very poor condition at the home of (Details with Directorate).
21. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will remove the empty mobile home from its current Location at Coolagowan, Listowel.

- 22. Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will investigate the cause of the flooding of the driveway at the home of (Details with Directorate).
- 23. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council would carry out urgent maintenance work and remove rubbish from Aghavallen Graveyard, Rusheen, Ballylongford, and also appoint a maintenance person to carry out regular maintenance as this Graveyard is on the Wild Atlantic Way & visited by tourists.
- 24. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council would erect a public light outside the new graveyard in Ballylongford
- 25. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council make vehicular access for residents parking in front of their houses on Bridge Road more accessible
- 26. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council would install footpath posts like we have in other areas as cars, tractors and all vehicles park on the footpath in Causeway, for safety reasons and as the footpaths are starting to deteriorate.
- 27. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council install public litter Bins in Causeway as there are none.
- 28. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council include the Tullamore road, Ballydonoghue, leading onto the L10009-0 on a Roads Programme as this road is in a very poor state.
- 29. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council mark out a second parking bay for the electric car charging point in the Square Listowel.
- 30. Cllr. J Moloney:** In conjunction with TII, can a slipway for small boats, canoes and kayaks off the new bridge on the bypass be built.
- 31. Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council investigate road L10559 from Laccamore to Dillons Cross, Abbeydorney. The road is in a very bad condition post Irish Water works and is in an unacceptable condition.

- 32. Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council review the signage for Ballybunion from other parts of the county. The signage is inadequate.
- 33. Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council repair the Liscullane Road Lixnaw, Co. Kerry. There are very bad potholes on the road.
- 34. Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council consider the inclusion of Liscullane Bridge works in the preliminary appraisal forms for the R556.
- 35. Cllr. A Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council confirm what progress has been made in relation to Kilflynn Cross.

- 1. Cllr. R Beasley:** When can we expect to see the Timber Seats painted on the Cliff Walk in Ballybunion?
- 2. Cllr. J Lucid:** When does Kerry County Council intend to install safety ramp at Sráid Thadhg Housing estate, Ballyheigue?
- 3. Cllr. J Lucid:** When will Kerry County Council roads design team have a design ready to implement to deal with the traffic calming at Abbeydorney Cross?
- 4. Cllr. J Lucid:** Has Kerry County Council put an agreed maintenance plan in place for Ardkeragh lock to prevent channel blocking and road flooding and can updates be provided at the area meeting?
- 5. Cllr. J Lucid:** What is the beach and street cleaning programme for Ballyheigue & Ballybunion for the summer and is there weekend work involved?
- 6. Cllr. T Barry:** As a result of the most recent act of vandalism in Listowel Town Park, will Kerry County Council install CCTV cameras to combat this type of behaviour?
- 7. Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council cut down a section of an overgrown ditch at a dangerous bend in the Bunplasha area of Duagh.

8. Cllr. M Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council please confirm where TII are in relation to St Michaels College Traffic Safety proposals and for the Listowel MD to request TII that these works will have to be carried out.
