1. Cllr. R Beasley: Why is Kerry County Council refusing to take in charge the following estates on the Bridge road, Listowel, - Castle Inch, The Meadows and The Paddocks while The Lodge estate has been taken in charge and this is part of the same lands.

2. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm what steps have been taken to secure road signage for Ballybunion as previously requested.

1. Cllr. J Moloney: Can the road design team begin work on the N69 Coolnaleen Cross to Moantcoal immediately?

2. Cllr. J Moloney: That the Listowel Municipal District assist in the landscaping of the public area outside the Council offices in Listowel.

3. Cllr. J Moloney: Can the "cuts" on the N69 in Tarbert be filled in or brought back to standard?

4. Cllr. T Barry: That Kerry County Council will consider providing lights for the remaining section of the Listowel town park.

5. Cllr. T Barry: That repair works will be carried on the road surface at Ardydonegan, Duagh.

6. Cllr. T Barry: Can Kerry County Council resolve the issue of water overflowing from the road onto the property of (Details with Directorate).

7. Cllr. R Beasley: That the fencing along the Dale road be repaired immediately. It is very unsightly and looks ugly. It is hard to imagine that fencing which was erected such a short time ago could be in such an appalling condition.

8. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council would examine the footpaths in the vicinity of the Church and school in Asdee village with a view to removing the moss which is rampant on the paths and is dangerous to walk on. The footpaths are mostly used by school children and elderly people attending the Church.

9. Cllr. R Beasley: That the Council fix the fencing around the Cliff Walk, Ballybunion which is broken and decayed in many places and dangerous for young children.

10. Cllr. L Purtill: That Kerry County Council would skirt and repair the Killelton road Ballylongford and also address the drainage issues on the road.

11. Cllr. L Purtill: The Tullahinell road in Ballylongford is now the worst road in the parish and is becoming a health & safety issue. I would urge Kerry County Council to put this road on a priority list for repairs.

12. Cllr. L Purtill: The Kilnaughtin burial ground committee wish to erect a permanent canopy over the alter which is in place. They would like to erect this canopy with advice from Peter Bradley EE. The committee keep the burial ground in pristine condition. This canopy is to facilitate mass in the graveyard. The alter is a fixed structure.

13. Cllr. L Purtill: That Kerry County Council would remove the ditch at the bend adjacent to the homes of (Details with Directorate) at Ardoughter, Ballyduff and replace it with timber fencing to improve the sight distance.

14. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out flood remedial works in and around Causeway village. Sand bags at every door in the village is not inviting.

15. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council resurface the Church car park in Causeway and re-design the car parking spaces.

16. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council engage immediately with the ESB with regard to the flooding that occurs at Knockamohane, Listowel. The residents of this area are living in fear of flooding.

17. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council install a digital reading speedometer in the Clieveragh area in Listowel where residents fear for their children's safety.

18. . Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council carry out drainage works at Dromature, Ballyheigue (L-1033-116) and carry out repairs on the road from Dromature to Ballyheigue.

19. Cllr. J Lucid: I ask that Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the slipway at Dromature Pier and to arrange to have dredging work carried out on the berthing area.

20. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council carry out drainage work and repairs to the road from Kilmoyley Church west as far as Banemore Cross L 1030.

21. Cllr. J Lucid: Will Kerry County Council acquire vacant possession of the land from the foreshore to the road at Dromature pier, Ballyheigue and transfer ownership of the site of the Inshore Rescue building to the Inshore Rescue group and the Coastguard.

22. Cllr. A Thornton: Can the Council confirm whether a submission can be made from the Listowel Municipal District for extra funding for roads considering the infrastructural damage caused by meeting national targets such as Wind Turbine and Eirgrid works.

23. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm what funding streams are available for works on John B Keane road as it is falling into a terrible state of disrepair.
