1. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council install cameras in the laneway at the rear of Feale Drive/Gleann a Phuca/O'Connell's Avenue to deal with the ongoing issue of the illegal dumping of rubbish in the area.
2. **Cllr. Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council immediately set up CCTV cameras in the laneway servicing O'Connell's Avenue and Feale Drive as illegal dumping is constantly happening. Latest episode, Thursday 10th of May.

1. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council install dog fouling warning notices at the entrance to The Writings Estate, Listowel, recently being taken in charge by Kerry County Council..

1. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council brief members on the acquisition of 38 houses in the Cahirdown Wood Estate in Listowel.

5. Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate

(b) Notices of Motion

1. **Cllr. T Barry:** When will the issue of repairing the road at Lower Aughrim, Moyvane be resolved.
2. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will carry out repairs to the road surface at Leitrim Middle, Moyvane.
3. **Cllr. T Barry:** Will Kerry County Council consider (Details with Directorate).

- 4. Cllr. T Barry:** Can Kerry County Council engage with the supermarkets in the area with regard to the amount of shopping trolleys that are been discarded in estates and laneways by a minority of their customers.
- 5. Cllr. J Moloney:** Can the extension of a footpath from entrance to Sli na Speire towards Bedford be looked at again?
- 6. Cllr. J Moloney:** Can the provision of bus stop in Duagh be investigated?
- 7. Cllr. J Moloney:** Can sight improvement works be undertaken at Lacey's Cross Asdee.
- 8. Cllr. J Moloney:** Is there an update from the roads design office on works on the N69.
- 9. Cllr. J Moloney:** Can Kerry County Council begin a development plan for the Town Park in Listowel with a view to securing funding.
- 10. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would put the Steeple road in Tarbert on the roads programme for 2009. It has deteriorated greatly in recent times and is in urgent need of resurfacing. In the meantime I would be very grateful if the road could be skirted and the potholes addressed. It can be a very busy road leading to the N69 and Moyvane.
- 11. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would surface dress the remainder of the Moyvane/Ballylongford road which has not been done and has greatly deteriorated because of the heavy trucks using it to deliver and draw material from the Lenamore wind farm.
- 12. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would skirt the Mortra road, Ballylongford. Drainage is a big issue on this road and when will this be addressed?
- 13. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would repair the damaged footpath at the entrance to (Details with Directorate)
- 14. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would fill the potholes on the old Reenturk school road, Kilcolgan, Tarbert. In reply to a previous motion it was stated that this work would be done.
- 15. Cllr. L Purtill:** Is an update available on the poor workmanship done recently from Lenamore Cross to the Cross of the Wood, by the wind turbine company.
- 16. Cllr. R Beasley:** That major repair works be carried out on all roads in the Listowel Municipal District where tens of millions in funding is needed to bring them back to some reasonable standard. Roads such as Tullahinell

North and South, the Tullamore road, Guhard road, Tullabeg road, Slieveadana road, Lahesrough road and Coole road.

17. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council consider extending the footpath out the Listowel road from Ahafona Cross to the speed limit.

18. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council remove the sand from Lower Knopogue road, Ballyduff which was blown up during the winter storms and has blocked drains and gullies that the Council did a lot of good work on in winter and spring 2016 . 2017.

19. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council examine the bend opposite Lacy's Cross in Asdee which is very dangerous as it is a very busy junction with a lot of traffic using the Tullahinell road and the local GAA grounds. This is a health and safety matter.

20. Cllr. R Beasley: That immediate action be taken to protect the sand dunes in Ballyheigue. There is one particular dune and if it is breached the Atlantic ocean will link up with the Cashen River and cut off Ballyheigue, Causeway and Ballyduff from the rest of North Kerry.

21. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council consider the purchase of 1.5 acres of land at the rear of Church Street, Listowel (rear of the Kingdom bar) for car parking.

22. Cllr. T Barry: Can Kerry County Council provide signs in Listowel Town Park highlighting to dog owners the importance of keeping them on a leash in a public place.

23. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out works at Killury Graveyard, Causeway as the entrance and lay by servicing this graveyard is in a desperate state.

24. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council skirt and resurface the L6053 . Lacca road as part of the Roads Programme 2019 . 2021.

25. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council install double yellow lines at both sides of the road servicing the Forge estate in Listowel.

26. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out immediate sight vision safety works at Coolkeragh West Cross maintenance restoration works are to commence here from Burntwood Cross.

27. Cllr. M Kennelly: I as a Councillor in the LMA cannot accept the delay in getting our potholes repaired. With some roads being reported to exist in excess of 10 weeks leading these roads to be in a desperate condition.

28. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council work to resolve the right of way issues with the road network for the Castleinch area of the Bridge road, Listowel.

29. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council carry out drainage works and road repairs to the Cleanderies road (L 6046) from Feans Cross, Causeway to Foleys Cross, Ballyheigue.

30. Cllr. J Lucid: I ask that Kerry County Council carry out repair work to the Line Road (L1031-106) from Ballinorig Cross west as far as (Details with Directorate).

31. Cllr. J Lucid: Are Kerry County Council committing to build a boundary wall at Cluain an Aisling Estate, Causeway in order to ensure there is not a repeat of the rat infestation that happened in 2017.

32. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council .carry out necessary repairs to the Liscullane road (10101-15) as the road is in a very poor condition again.

33. Cllr. J Lucid: I ask that Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the Lackabeg road L 10561-0. Places, on the section of this road on the Abbeydorney are in danger of collapsing into the open drains by the side of the road.

34. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council carry out minor drainage work and repair ditch on the road L 6084-0 near the property of (Details with Directorate).

35. Cllr. J Lucid: Can the road from Morgan's Cross/Ahanagran Cross, Ballylongford be put on the roads programme for 2018.

36. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council consider when works can be done on the footpaths leading into the Cloisters Estate, Abbeydorney.

37. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm where the project of the new graveyard at Lixnaw lies ?

38. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm what the position is re Kilmoyley Graveyard and what funding is held for these works by Kerry County Council.

39. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council address works on the Finuge roads as there are a number of dangerous undulations.

40. Cllr. A Thornton: That Kerry County Council include Ballyrehan, Lixnaw Road on the next Roads Programme as it is in an unacceptable state.

41. Cllr. A Thornton: That Kerry County Council confirm what Kerry beaches were machine cleaned prior to the May bank holiday weekend.

42. Cllr. A Thornton: That Kerry County Council confirm when the works at Kilflynn Cross can commence.

- 2. Cllr. R Beasley:** When can we expect to see the public toilets commence in Ballybunion?

- 4. Cllr. R Beasley:** Will Kerry County Council remove the sand at the bend on the Knopogue road on the road going down to the Cashen?
- 5. Cllr. R Beasley:** What is the up to date with the Bog road in Ballyheigue?
- 6. Cllr. M Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council include the Glouria road, Ballydonoghue on the Roads Programme 2019 . 2021 and can this road be repaired and skirted immediately as this road has deteriorated completely?
- 7. Cllr. M Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council give details of the ongoing problems at the ESB Sub-Station at Trierenagh. A section of road here is now in a desperate state and also the threat of flooding to residents is an everyday reality.
- 8. Cllr. M Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council advise on the criteria in obtaining a Parking Permit for the town of Listowel?
- 9. Cllr. M Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council give an immediate start date for works on the long proposed footpath in the Upper Dromin/Cahirdown Area?
- 10. Cllr. J Lucid:** When will drainage works be completed at Tillaughna, Causeway?
- 11. Cllr. J Lucid:** What progress has been made in relation to providing a decision on the method to improve traffic control at Abbeydorney cross roads.
- 12. Cllr. J Lucid:** Can I get an update when the footpath is completed and the speed ramps are put at Benmore Estate, Ballyduff.
- 13. Cllr. J Lucid:** Is there a work plan in place for the 2018 footpath repair programme and when will the works start at Ballyheigue, Abbeydorney and Lixnaw.

14. Cllr. J Lucid: When are Kerry County Council going to rebuild the wall (that was knocked through flooding in November 2017) at Marion Terrace, Causeway.

1. Cllr. L Purtill: That Kerry County Council would call on the Minister for Communications to ensure the retention of a Post Office in the Parish of Ballylongford. I was amazed to hear that two Post Offices in the Parish have been offered exit packages. The Parish has a population in excess of 1,500 and it is vital that we retain our Post Office to prevent further rural isolation. There is an alternative site available in the Village in the local supermarket who are currently employing 25 people and servicing the Ballylongford / Asdee area.

2. Cllr. R Beasley: That all political parties desist from erecting posters in towns and villages in all future elections and referendums in conjunction with tidy towns groups etc.

3. Cllr. A Thornton: That Kerry County Council again write to Minister Ross to meet a delegation regarding the Dale Road and roads in North Kerry in general.
