1. **Cllr. M. Kennelly:** Is Kerry County Council Housing Department purchasing 4 Bed houses in North Kerry? If not, why?

5. Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate

(a) To note update report from the Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate.

(b) Notices of Motion

1. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would line the road from Tarbert to Tarbert Island. The white line is obliterated in parts of this road.
2. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would resolve an ongoing drainage problem outside the home of (Details with Directorate) at Tieraclea, Tarbert. This is a drain blocked at this location since the N69 was upgraded. The contractor used this area as a laydown for material causing a blockage in the drain. Kerry County Council gave a commitment to resolve the problem by early 2018. There is a huge ponding of water after very little rainfall which will only get worse as the winter progresses. Will Kerry County Council address this issue as a priority.
3. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** What is the update on the work to be carried out in Main Street, Ballylongford, brown water is springing up through the road outside

(Details with Directorate). They have spent a large sum of money on paint and masonry work which is being destroyed by stains from the muddy water ponding on the road.

4. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** Would Kerry County Council fill the potholes to maintain this road at Derryvrin Rd, Abbeydorney. This road is in very bad condition and can it be put on the next roads programme.
5. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would address a problem with flooding at Carhoona, Tarbert, adjacent to the house of (Details with Directorate). I had a similar motion to Kerry County Council 12 months ago, regarding the seriousness of this problem and work was to be carried out there in early 2018.
6. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would surface the Creamery Road off Chapel Street, Tarbert, from Carmody's to the Old Creamery.
7. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That road markings need to be redone in many main and secondary roads throughout North Kerry and throughout the County.
8. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That the solar lights outside Killury school be fixed as they have not worked for a long period of time and that all solar lights be checked outside schools throughout the County as we move into the Winter months in the interest of safety.
9. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** I ask that Kerry County Council carry out a proper repair to the line road (L 1031–106) on the section from Ballinorig Cross West to beyond Egan's. Lags have developed on both sides of the road due to heavy traffic, making it dangerous for cars using the road.
10. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** I call on Kerry County Council to install speed ramps and CCTV in (Details with Directorate).
11. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** In the interest of safety that public lighting is continued up Dromin to the town boundary to include The (Details with Directorate).
11. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** Can traffic calming measures be placed in Kenny Heights. Build outs have been suggested.
12. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** What is the policy or powers of the Council when dealing with animal fouling and excrement on public road?
13. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** Can we ensure that all manhole covers on roads are in their correct and safe positions?
14. **Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council install bollards in Causeway village as cars, tractors and other vehicles are continuously parking on the footpaths.

15. **Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council carry out works to the rain water drainage system and grids in the Lartigue Village Estate Listowel.
16. **Cllr. M. Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council please explain to the residents of the Dromin area in Listowel that the construction of a footpath approved of 2 years ago for the safety of their children is still not completed.
17. **Cllr. A. Thornton:** Can Kerry County Council please confirm the likely progress of the bypass over the next 6 months.
18. **Cllr. A. Thornton:** When is the earliest date that works may be carried out on the John B Keane Road as part of the bypass works.

6. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council carry out repairs on the North Road at Drimnacurra, Causeway from the (Details with Directorate) to the Lodge Cross (L 1032-100 to L 1032 079)?
7. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council clean the drains and manholes and also skirt the road near the (Details with Directorate) at Ballinorig Cross to stop the water lodging outside his gate (L 1034 -47)?
8. **Cllr. J. Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council clear the drains at Dreenagh, Ballyheigue (L 1033-56) before the end of 2018.
9. **Cllr. M. Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council carry out drainage works to flooding issues in the (Details with Directorate) in Listowel where this occurs inside the pedestrian gate entrance of the estate?
10. **Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council immediately remedy the issue of flooding adjacent to the Picnic area in Tarbert.

- 11. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council install stop signs throughout the Woodview Estate, Listowel?
- 12. Cllr. M. Kennelly:** Are Kerry County Council currently maintaining Listowel Municipal Districts local road network?
