3. Cllr. J Moloney: That the Listowel Municipal District contact Irish Water to ensure that the new pumping system in Scartlea is made an absolute priority.

4. Cllr. J Moloney: Can the sewer at the rear of (Details with Directorate) be investigated for potential blockages?

5. Cllr. J Lucid: Will Kerry County Council please investigate why part of the footpath (about 80 metres approx) near Ballyheigue Church, was not properly reinstated when new pipes was put in.

1. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm if there is a current insulation scheme for housing?

1. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council put up a *No Entry* sign on the end of the road coming down to the Mens Beach and Long Strand where people keep getting stuck in the sand.

2. Cllr. R Beasley: How soon can we expect to see road restoration works carried out on the roads at Tullamore, Ballybunion and Francis road which are in a deplorable condition.

3. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council put in a strip of tarmacadam on the Cliff Road, Ballybunion from Horgan Drapers Shop up to Carrig Lee guest house. This area includes the doctor's surgery where many elderly people attend. This was promised to be done earlier in the year.

4. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council examine the problem with water flooding outside the home of (Details with Directorate)

5. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council's Roads Department examine the road about half a mile after Dirha Cottages towards Lisselton where there are very large lags which are certainly a safety issue.

6. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council take immediate action where there is a big problem with flood water entering the back yards at St Patricks terrace, Tarbert.

7. Cllr. R Beasley: That Kerry County Council make openings on the side of the roads to take surface water which is eroding many good roads and roads that are not so good, one example is the North Road from Lacca Cross to Causeway where a lot of water is lodging.

8. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council erect *Reduce Speed* signs on the Mountcoal Road adjacent to the St. Senan's football pitch as cars are speeding on this road and also that repairs are carried out on this road.

9. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out remedial works at Causeway Village where the new road resurfacing has taken place. Some areas along the footpath are now holding a lot of water.

10. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out road repairs and erect proper signage on the dangerous section of the Dromin road, Listowel, heading for Clounmacon.

11. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council immediately carry out the reconstruction of Callaghan's Cross, Ballylongford as this area has been highlighted to Kerry County Council on numerous occasions. It has been completely destroyed and luckily no accidents have occurred in this area.

12. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out road skirting and repairs on the Gortamashilla Road leading onto the Tubertoren Road in Moyvane due to flooding on the sides of the road. This road is now being used heavily due to diversions for the GNI Gas Line to Listowel.

13. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out immediate roadworks in the Woodview estate, Listowel, just after the entrance as this section has been destroyed and with a manhole now at least 6 inches over the road surface which is dangerous and totally unacceptable.

14. Cllr. M Kennelly: That Kerry County Council carry out immediate road drainage works at the Six Crosses, Listowel on both sides. This has been an ongoing issue which is eroding the road surface and which requires Kerry County Council to resurface this short section of road.

15. Cllr. L Purtill: That Kerry County Council would trim the hedge from the bridge into Carrig Island to the old derelict bridge on the Coast Road. The hedge is very overgrown and this is a very popular route for walkers and tourists.

16. Cllr. L Purtill: That Kerry County Council would repair the road near Irremore Church leading to the N69 Tralee/Listowel road.

17. Cllr. L Purtill: That Kerry County Council give an update on when the reinstatement of the roads from the Tullahinnell North and South windfarm will begin. How much of the Bond has been spent to date and how much remains to be spent. The residents living on and using the roads are concerned about the condition of the roads and the fast approaching winter months.

18. Cllr. J Lucid: Will Kerry County Council investigate the extent of a void underneath the concrete slip way at Dromature Pier so that a process can be put in place to have necessary repairs carried out.

19. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council examine the drainage in the centre of Ballyduff village from the entrance to the square to the far side of the Garda Station. Buildings in the middle of the village barely escaped flooding earlier this year during heavy rain.

20. Cllr. J Lucid: Will Kerry County Council please remove the loose stones stacked on the footpath on the south side of Causeway Cemetery.

21. Cllr. J Lucid: Will Kerry County Council arrange to have a traffic volume analysis carried out on the Lackamore road Abbeydorney with a view to upgrading the status of the road from local road to regional road.

22. Cllr. J Lucid: Will Kerry County Council put double yellow lines on Ballyduff village at both sides of the exit from Tower Drive estate in order to improve safety of road users leaving the estate.

23. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council look at (Details with Directorate) to see if a solution can be put in place to divert surface water going into his yard.

24. Cllr. J Lucid: Can Kerry County Council look at (Details with Directorate) to see if a solution can be put in place to divert surface water from flooding their home.

25. Cllr. A Thornton: What is the update in relation to Kilflynn Cross?

26. Cllr. A Thornton: Can training be provided to parents of children attending Kilflynn National School so that they can provide an adult school warden service at the school.

27. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm the exact commitment regarding the road reinstatement in the village of Moyvane post works by GNI and Eirgrid.

28. Cllr. A Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm how the road diversion will be dealt with in the village of Moyvane to facilitate works by GNI and Eirgrid.

29. Cllr. A Thornton: What is the position regarding the traffic review for St. Michaels school?

30. Cllr. A Thornton: What is the position regarding the review of the entrance in to the Listowel Town Park?
