1. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** Ballylongford is one of the few villages in North Kerry that does not have a children's playground. Several meetings have taken place in the past to identify a suitable site, without any success. Kerry County Council may have a suitable site in the village which was looked at recently. I would appreciate if this site could be prioritised for a children's playground.
2. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That KCC erect a plaque to commemorate the first transmit from West to East in March 1919 on the Marconi site, Sand Hill Road, Ballybunion
3. **Cllr. T. Barry:** That Kerry County Council will install CCTV cameras for a trial period at locations where there is a high level of anti-social behaviour.
4. **Cllr. T. Barry:** That Kerry County Council will endeavour to provide equipment suitable for use for children with disabilities in our parks and playgrounds.
5. **Cllr. J Moloney:** Following the success with the green flag in Listowel Town Park. Are Kerry County Council going to draw up a development plan for the Park.

1. **Cllr. J Moloney:** Has there been any progress on a proposed allotment in Listowel?

3. Quality of Life - Water, Environment, Fire and Library Services Directorate

1. **Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would investigate the Waste Water System at Kilpadogue, across from the Comprehensive School. The pipes are running at the back of these houses and a stench can be detected. (Details with Directorate)

2. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council get Irish Water to properly restore the Lackamore road from Dillon's Cross to Lackabeg Cross as a matter of great urgency. They have left this road in a terrible condition for over 2 years.

(d) Questions

1. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council give an update on the Duagh Sewerage System upgrade. Duagh has been successful in securing a place on the pilot scheme and are still awaiting an update on proceedings.

4. Housing & Corporate Services Directorate

1. **Cllr. L. Purtill:** Has Kerry County Council had any communication taken place with the Developer that owns 5 houses in Quay Street. They are rented to tenants of Kerry County Council. Pressure should be put on the developer to paint these houses and surface the area in front of these houses.

(e) Questions

1. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** Can Kerry County Council investigate a housing issue in which some of our housing stock which has been allocated have an electricity only means of lighting, cooking and heating. The cost to tenants are over excessive?
2. **Cllr. R Beasley:** How soon can we expect to see CCTV cameras erected in Benmore Estate Ballyduff?

5. Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate

(a) To note update report from the Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate.

(b) Notices of Motion

- 1. Cllr. R Beasley:** That the new footpath coming into Ballybunion to Afahona to the Men's shed be properly tarred where the New Zealand flak was planted and failed to grow and was removed by the Tidy Towns on the instructions of Kerry County Council.
- 2. Cllr. R Beasley:** That the sign on the Dale Road, indicating Ballyduff and Tralee be straightened, as it is interfering with visibility for people coming up from Ahabeg West.
- 3. Cllr. R Beasley:** That new litter bins be put into our towns in the next 3 years
- 4. Cllr. L Purtill:** That Kerry County Council would support calls from Tarbert Development Association to Transport Infrastructure Ireland to reduce the speed limit to 50 KPH on the road from Tarbert to Tarbert Island on the N69. This is a very busy road with traffic from the car ferry and the power station. It is used by many people walking, parents with children, and cyclists. The footpath does not stretch the length of this road and it is essential that the speed limit is reduced to 50KPH.
- 5. Cllr. J Lucid:** I ask that Kerry County Council carry out a proper repair be to the line road (L 1031-106) on the section from Ballinorig cross west to beyond Egan's. Lags have developed on both sides of the road due to heavy traffic, making it dangerous for cars using the road.
- 6. Cllr. J Lucid:** I ask that Kerry County Council support calls from Tarbert Development Association to ask Transport Infrastructure Ireland to set a speed limit of 50km per hour on the N67 road from Tarbert Ferry to the village.
- 7. Cllr. J Moloney:** Can a program of upgrading and replacing rubbish bins in the area be started.

8. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That KCC urgently supply refuse bins to the Ballybunion area from Ahafona Cross to the Garda Station as littering is a serious issue in the area and this will help relieve the issues highlight recently in the An Taisce Report into Ballybunion.

9. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council will put in place measures to insure the safety of pedestrians and motorists at the area in front of McKenna's Hardware shop Listowel following two incidents there in the recent past.

10. **Cllr. T Barry:** That Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the road at Clounmacon to Clountubrid Cross as the road has deteriorated very much and ins in an unsafe condition in some areas.

11. **Cllr J Moloney:** Has any progress been made with the TII on the N69 at Caherdown.

12. **Cllr. J Moloney:** What plans are in place to further develop the Greenway into Listowel as to ensure maximum benefit and impact.

13. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That KCC carry out immediate safety works at the crossroad junction known as Moran's Cross in Asdee. This cross is one of the most dangerous in the County and residents fear the worst at this junction.

1. **Cllr. R Beasley:** What is the up to date information in relation to the extension to St. John's graveyard Causeway?

2. **Cllr. R Beasley:** What is the up to date information in relation to the information that was given to the Ballyduff Tidy Towns concerning the erection of an information board, some seating, unfinished footpaths, and other remedial works that were expected to be carried out before the end of the season?

3. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** What is the update info in relation to the public toilets in Ballybunion?

4. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Funding has been allocated for drainage works at Cleanderies (L 6046) & Lisduff (L 10430-10), when is this work scheduled to go ahead.
5. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the small car park at Meenogohane pier?
6. **Cllr. J Lucid:** Can Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the road at Dromature, Ballyheigue from Godleys to the pier?
7. **Cllr. J Lucid:** That Kerry County Council carry out repairs to the road from Kilmoyley Church to Banemore Cross. (L 1030-10)
8. **Cllr. T Barry:** Can repairs be carried out to the road surface on the Leanemore Road as it is in very bad as it is in very bad condition?
9. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That Kerry County Council investigate the road known as Poul Line which has recently been patched was damaged by heavy trucks supplying stone to the area for works on a ESB pylon. This road needs to be urgently included in the new roads program.

2. **Cllr. M Kennelly:** That KCC ensure that on the sale of the Tarbert/Ballylongford landbank which has been in state ownership for the past sixty years that a percentage of the sale price be deposited with KCC to provide proper infrastructure and to fulfil job creation in North Kerry.

2. Cllr. T Barry: Will all residents in Listowel town be able to connect to the gas service?
