Cllr M Cahill referred to the allocation of " 500 towards St. Mary of the Angels. He asked that Senior Management would consider facilitating a fund raising event to help charities in the county. He said that it has come to a stage where more and more funding is required to help charities survive. He expressed disappointment that many groups received less of an allocation than last year. He referred to the county wide projects and asked that they would be decided at Municipal District level rather than Full Council. He referred to the " 72,000 allocated towards the Rural and Village Development scheme and said he had an issue with such a high percentage of the Community Support Fund pre allocated.

Cllr D Quigg seconded Cllr M Cahill's proposal for Kerry County Council to facilitate a fund raising event. He asked that the South & West Kerry Municipal District would spear head a Wild Atlantic Way conference.

Cllr J Healy-Rae acknowledged the work of the staff of the Economic and Community Department in compiling the document and said it isn't easy to balance the budget. He welcomed the council's proposal to set up a project to map the location of Defibrillators in the county. He suggested that an App would be created highlighting same and that the location of defibrillators county wide would be available on Kerry County Council's website. He expressed concern regarding the " 72,000 allocated towards the Rural and Village Development scheme. To date we don't know what projects will be approved and in the case where an application has been unsuccessful, he said he didn't want a situation where there is urgency to spend the money at the end of the year. He requested that between " 4,000 and " 5,000 would remain unallocated next year. He welcomed the allocation of " 500 towards St Marys of the Angels. He referred to the proposal of one substantial application being submitted per town through their Chamber Alliance and said that he didn't want the smaller community projects to suffer as a result of this and requested that the members would be advised how the money will be distributed. He said that the smaller projects shouldn't be at the expense of the bigger projects and referred in particular to the allocation of " 400 to the Christmas in Kilgarvan committee and said that this is a small project, however the contribution is very welcomed and will help enormously towards running the event.

Cllr P Connor-Scarteen thanked the staff of the Economic and Community Development Directorate for compiling the document. He stated that a number of the applicants will not be happy with their allocations. He asked that the funding would be more evenly distributed amongst the four Municipal Districts next year. He supported Cllr J Healy-Rae's proposal to keep the sum of " 5,000 unallocated next year.

Cllr N Moriarty welcomed the document and thanked the staff of Kerry County Council for compiling same and for facilitating the information meetings on the Community Support Fund. She referred to the substantial number of applications received and suggested that a condition would be introduced that once a group receives funding, they are not permitted to apply for at least two years. She said that the purpose of the Community Support Fund is to allow groups to set up and become self sufficient and shouldn't continue to rely on the Community Support Fund for funding. She referred to the allocation of " 72,000 towards the Rural and Village Development Scheme and said that notification should be received by April as to what projects have been successful for funding. If projects are unsuccessful, the funding can be redistributed. She highlighted that in the last two years only three groups in the South & West Kerry Municipal District received the full allocation they requested.

Cllr S Fitzgerald welcomed the document and acknowledged the work involved in assessing the applications. He referred to the proposal of the bigger towns submitting one application from their Chamber Alliance and cautioned that the smaller groups in rural areas can't be left out. He asked are all allocations fully audited and do the council request proof of spending.

Ms. N O'Sullivan said that very strict procedures and guidelines were introduced to ensure that all groups spend the allocation on what it was approved for. They are required to fill up a completion report and submit relevant receipts. If any group didn't submit receipts in 2016 and have applied again this year, the Economic & Community Department will not pay them until all receipts are submitted.

Cllr N Moriarty asked was there a timeframe for submitting documentation for payment.

Ms. N O'Sullivan replied that applicants have until the end of 2017 to submit their receipts. The Economic & Community Department has facilitated the closing of 2016 applications up until the end of March 2017 to submit the relevant documentation.

Cllr J Healy-Rae asked that all unsuccessful applicants would be written to and advised why their applications were unsuccessful.

Mr. N O'Sullivan stated that it is part of the policy of the Community Support Fund to write to all unsuccessful applicants and advise them of other avenues of funding if applicable.

Cllr M Cahill suggested that in the event of a group receiving a substantial allocation, he requested that a timeframe would be introduced to prevent this particular group from reapplying to give other groups a chance to receive funding.

Cllr D McCarthy thanked the members for allowing him the opportunity to chair the meeting.

On the PROPOSAL of Cllr. P Connor-Scarreen SECONDED by Cllr D Quigg it was agreed to approve the allocations from the 2017 Community Support Fund for the Municipal District of South & West Kerry as outlined in the report circulated.

### **Killorglin Courthouse**
