TRALEE - FENIT GREENWAY

Public Notice in Compliance with Part XI of the Planning & Development Act 2000-2017 as set down in Part VIII of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001-2018

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, Notice is hereby given that Kerry County Council proposes to carry out the development, particulars of which are set out hereunder:-

(i) Location/Townland or Postal Address of the Proposed Development

Location: Tralee(Ballynahoulort) to Fenit Village (Fenit Without)

(ii) Nature and extent of the Proposed Works

The proposed development consists of the construction of a greenway on the route of the disused Tralee to Fenit railway line from the townland of Ballynahoulort in Tralee to the village of Fenit for the sole use of pedestrian and cyclist only.

The route is approximately 10.5km in length and will begin at Bracker O'Regan Road and finish in Fenit Without.

The main works will include the following:

- The clearance of vegetation on the rail line corridor, retaining existing boundary hedgerows and boundary vegetation where possible
- The lifting of the old railway rails
- The laying of a 3 meter wide bituminous tarmacadam surface on a crushed stone base
- Repair and upgrade of the existing drainage network
- Reinstatement of an underbridge and associated stone abutments at Kilfenora
- Reinstatement of a number of agricultural underpasses
- Removal of a number of existing masonry stone abutments
- Provision of access controls (pedestrian/cycling friendly gates) road makings, traffic calming measures on the greenway.
- Provision of agricultural, combined and residential crossings
- Installation of safety barriers where required
- Boundary treatment works including the installation of stock proof fencing, security fencing, privacy screening, planting and boundary walls

Best practice Environmental Management Measures shall be adhered to throughout the proposed development.
