**NOTICE OF THE SUBMISSION OF SIGNIFICANT ADDITIONAL DATA IN RELATION TO
THE ABOVE**

In accordance with Section 51 (2) of the Roads Act 1993, as amended, Kerry County Council (the Applicant) made an application for permission to An Bord Pleanála on the 29th August, 2018 in relation to the proposed South Kerry Greenway as described above from the townland of Reenard southwest of Cahirciveen to the townland of Faha west of Glenbeigh, County Kerry.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) were submitted as part of that application.

In response to a requirement issued by An Bord Pleanála under section 217(4)(a) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as amended, Further Information in relation to the proposed road development has been furnished to An Bord Pleanála on the 8th April, 2019. The further information submitted contains significant additional data in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed road development.

- (iii) The reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full.
