Objectives:

Objective No.	It is an objective of the Council to:
A-1	Encourage the sustainable development of a central amenity space to act as a village park.
TL-1	Promote, develop and maintain, in a sustainable manner, a recreational walking / cycling trail along the canal and disused railway line as part of a wider recreational greenway system while protecting features of biodiversity and cultural importance.
EN-1	Encourage environmental improvements to up-grade the streetscape and add continuity to an otherwise disjointed streetscape while protecting features of architectural and cultural importance.
MU-1	Zone lands for the environmentally sustainable development of mixed uses at appropriate locations to provide for the expansion of local employment, retail and service uses while protecting features of biodiversity and cultural importance
BH-1	Protect the stone walls
NE-1	Safeguard biodiversity interests of designated nature conservation sites in the area.
