Kerry County Development Plan 2022-2028

A chara

I have become aware of the current work which is underway on the new Kerry County Development Plan 2022 to 2028. Unfortunately I learned too late of the webinar which was scheduled for 02 July. I am pleased to learn that submissions or observations from the public are invited and I wish to propose the following, for your consideration.

Improved pedestrian and cyclist experience in Ballybunion.

1. Provide a **continuous footpath** along Cliff Road from its junction at The Bunker Bar, Main Street to its junction at Church Road (Cliff House corner), to eliminate the necessity for pedestrians to have to twice cross the road unnecessarily.
2. Relocate footpath around Seaview Park to the opposite side of the road, and thereby gain wider path / parking area, safer driving conditions and safer pedestrian conditions.
3. Promote the use of the existing pathway from Cregan's Corner along the coastal side of the playground, towards the lower end of Main Street, exiting at "Hawney's" / former entrance to the Castle Hotel, by upgrading that path's surface and lighting.
4. Provide a footpath on Sandhill Road from McMunn's (top of road to Men's Beach) to the Library and on towards the Golf Course.
5. Provide a footpath on Spraymount Road, (from Church Road, near St John's Church, to Cliff Road).
6. Provide a footpath on the stretch of Church Road from Cliff Road end at Cliff House to the corner on Church Road & along the road towards the church.
7. Improve visual appearance of Cliff Road by replacing the inappropriate fencing around Seaview Park with an appropriate, secure, safe fence,
8. Add bike parking facilities in some key locations – eg near playground, near supermarket, town centre, near library, near beaches, the Castle Green.
9. Provide Cycle routes/paths.
10. Widen footpaths, where possible, to allow for physical distancing.

11. Provide safe pedestrian crossing points at the key locations, e.g. access points to beaches

Litter / Waste management

1. Increase the number and size of public bins, both on the beaches and in the town. It would be far healthier and cheaper to spend on prevention than on cleaning up the mess.
2. Have recycling facilities at caravan parks, in supermarket car parks everywhere.

Thank you for the opportunity to make submissions and for taking them into consideration as you design the new 2022 to 2028 County Development Plan. We look forward to seeing the fruits of the plan in the years ahead.
