Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, and the Temporary Closing of Roads Regulations 1994, Kerry County Council **has decided** to close to public traffic the roads as detailed below in order to facilitate the installation of joint bays and carry out directional drilling under the Ahavanlaumen River as part of the Killpaddoge to Knockanure 220kv circuit project.

Road No. L6020 – L1010 – R551 From Coolnagoonagh to Carhoona From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between the dates of Monday 14 th May to Thursday 14 th June
Road No. R551 – L6020 – L1013 From Carhoona to Cross of the Woods From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between the dates of Thursday 24 th May to Thursday 7 th June
Road No. L1013 – L1012 on R551 From Meelcon Cross to Tarmons Cross, Moyvane Village From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between the dates of Monday 28 th May to Thursday 28 th June
Road No. L1021 – L1012 From Tarmons Cross to Moyvane Village From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between the dates of Monday 11 th June to Wednesday 11 th July
Road No. L6036 on R523 – L1023 From Athea to Listowel Road to Kilmeany Crossroads From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between the dates of Monday 25 th June to Wednesday 25 th July
Road No. L1021 – R523 From Athea to Listowel Road to Knockanure Graveyard From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between the dates of Monday 9 th July to Thursday 9 th August
Road No. R523 – L3036 – L1021 From L6036 Road to Kilmorna to L1021 Knockanure Cross From 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Monday 16 th July 2018 (one day only)

The purpose of the road closure is to facilitate the installation of joint bays and carry out directional drilling under the Ahavanlaumen River as part of the Killpaddoge to Knockanure 220kv circuit project.

Alternative routes will be signposted and access will be provided for Emergency Services and local residents. Diversions will be available via local roads.
