ORDÚ LUASTEORANN OIBREACHA BÓTHAIR/ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

An tAcht um Thrácht ar Bhóithre 2004/Road Traffic Act, 2004

In accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, notice is hereby given that a Road Works Speed Limit Order has been made on a section of the N72 National Secondary Road between Killarney and Barraduff, in the interests of road safety and in order to facilitate pavement improvement works in connection with the N72 Knockeenagowan to Barraduff Pavement Improvement Scheme, thereby providing safer conditions for road users and construction workers.

The Road Works Speed Limit to be applied is 60 km/h.

The speed limit will apply for the period from Wednesday, 19th June 2019 and will remain in place until Friday, 5th June 2020 (both dates inclusive).

The temporary Speed Limit signs are to be erected on a section of the N72 National Secondary Road between Killarney and Barraduff, approximately 1,700m in length in a westerly direction from the existing 50km/h speed limit at Barraduff.

Regard shall be given to any representations that are made, in writing, to Charlie O'Sullivan, Director of Services, Operations, Capital Infrastructure and Safety Department, Áras an Chontae, Tralee, County Kerry, in relation to this Road Works Speed Limit Order.
