#### LOCAL IMPROVEMENT SCHEME SCHEME FOR THE FUNDING OF IMPROVEMENT WORKS TO PRIVATE ROADS (NON-PUBLIC ROADS)

Applications are invited from residents/users of private roads (non-public roads) who wish to participate in a scheme involving the improvement of these access roads.

The scheme is subject to strict criteria and conditions set down by the Department of Rural and Community Development.

Principally qualifying roads **must**:-

- Provide access to parcels of land of which at least 2 are owned/occupied by different persons engaged in separate agricultural activities or;
- Provide access for harvesting purposes (including turf or seaweed) for 2 or more persons, or;
- Shall in the opinion of the County Council be “**used by the public**” (this means that works may be undertaken to a road which, while not a public road, may connect two public roads or give access to a beach or commonage and thereby serve the local community).

Persons who have submitted applications previously under this scheme, after the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008, **do not** have to submit a new application.

Kerry County Council proposes to compile a prioritised list of Local Improvement Schemes which it is hoped will commence in 2019.

- Slí isteach a chur ar fáil le haghaidh cursaí bainte (móin agus feamainn san áireamh) do bheirt nó níos mó, nú;
- A bheidh i dtuairim An Chomhairle Contae a “úsaid ag an bpobal” (cialaíonn seo gur féidir oibreacha a dhéanamh ar an mbóthar, cé nách bóthar poiblí é, a d’fhéadfadh dhá bhóthar poiblí a cheangal le chéile nó a thabhrfadh slí isteach go trá nó coimín agus da réir a raghadh chun leasa an phobail áitiúil).

Ma tá foirm iarratais againn cheana ó dhaoine faoin scéim seo ón 1ú Eanáir, 2008 i leith, **ní gá** iarratas nua a chur isteach.

Tá ar aigne ag Comhairle Contae Chiarraí liosta tús áite a chur le chéile do Scéimeanna Feabhsúcháin Áitiúla agus súil againn sin a thosnú i 2019.
